#### Mixed Team Event (62nd Inter-District Championship): the following guidelines have to follow

a) Sequence of each tie:

M: 9826033644

- 1<sup>st</sup> Men Single
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Women Single
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Men Double
- 4th Men Single
- 5<sup>th</sup> Mixed Double.
- b) One team consists of 5 male players, 2 female players & 1 manager/coach (male/female).
- c) No player shall play in more than 2 events. (but not both the singles)
- d) A Player can play in 1 Single & 1 Double.
- e) All teams have to give their players name in order of strength & that will remain same throughout the championship.
- f) Play in the tie shall be stopped whenever the tie is decided in 3 matches. It may be 3-0, 3-1 or 3-2.
- g) If a player withdraws in singles, he/she permitted to participate in pair event in the same tie.
- h) Any change of sequence in order of play in the following tie shall be informed to the Referee in writing before 2 hours of the commencement of the tie; the Referee shall inform such changes to the opponent team immediately.
- i) A player who withdraws in one tie is permitted to play in the next tie.
- j) Any player participating in 2 matches is entitled to a minimum interval of 20 minutes between them in a same tie.

### 10) MODE OF COMPETITION:

All the matches in the main draw shall be played best of 3 games of 21 points on a rally point system

approved by BAI/BWF. All the matches in the qualifying draw shall be played best of 3 games of 15

points each without extension

## 11) DRAW:

The maximum draw size of the main draw shall be as under:

In case of vacancy in size of main draw players, the draw should fill with more qualifiers. There shall not be any restriction on the size of the qualifying draw. The draw will be done at MPBA office through the Tournament Planner software.

All events will be run on a strict timetable system; players must be ready to play fifteen (15) minutes before their scheduled match time.

#### 12) PROTEST

The fees for lodging protest of any kind shall be Rs. 1000/-. This fee shall be retained by the organizers of the event. Any Protest shall be addressed to the Org. Secretary in writing within one hour after completion of the match or 4 hours before commencement of the match.

Organizers have to provide Lodging & Boarding to person who is attending the Championship as an physiotherapist with the Technical Officials.

## 15) TECHNICAL OFFICIALS:

The Technical officials will be nominated later.

#### 16) OTHER POINTS:

- a) The host Organizers shall nominate one local Assistant/Coordinator who will assist the Referee for smooth conduct of event along with one Laser printer with sufficient A4 size paper & one Net Setter for Internet Connection & other stationary items list is attached as Annexure B in the end of this circular.
